

Guide to e-Boks and MitID

You may have noticed in your letter of employment that it says your salary slip will be available in your e-boks – what exactly is e-Boks, and how does it work? We hope this small guide to e-boks and MitID will make it a little easier to figure out e-boks and finding your salary slip.

What is e-Boks?

e-Boks is actually just a platform on which you receive digital mail from both public and private sectors. There are several platforms you can choose to use to read your digital mail, e-Boks is just one of them.

There are three options you can choose, all three has an app you can install on your phone for easier access to your mail:

- e-Boks
- <u>Digital Post</u> (lifeindenmark.dk)
- Mit.dk

No matter which you choose to use, you login by using your MitID and you can set it up so you either get an email or a text when there is something new in your inbox.

If you choose to use e-Boks, you might need to check that you are also receiving mail from the public authorities, as this might not be the automatic choice, since e-Boks stopped their collaboration with the public authorities when mit.dk became the go-to.

Now what is MitID - and how do I get it?

Now, you might be very new to Denmark and wonder, what is MitID and how do I get it. MitID is a digital ID used in Denmark to verify your identity, when you shop online, log onto your online bank or log into your digital mailbox.

<u>MitID</u> comes as an app for your smartphone, where you log in with a personal code. If you use MitID on a different screen than your smartphone, you might need to scan a QR-code on top of the password.

You do not need a CPR number to set up MitID.
