


# Development in the share of graduates who will recommend CBS

Increase in the share of graduates who will recommend others either to take an education at CBS or to take the same education at CBS

From 2016 to 2020, the share of graduates who would recommend taking an education at CBS has increased from 77% to 96%.

From 2016 to 2020, the share of graduates who would recommend taking the same education at CBS has increased from 67% to 85%.




# Important and missing elements related to employment

Student job is listed by the graduates from CBS to be the most important element related to employment. Followed by skills obtained during the time of studying and network.


Lack of specialized competencies and network are indicated to be the two most influent elements related to graduate employment. And lack of experience from student job is said by graduates to be an important element in relation to employment – though relatively lower ranked.

The two charts reflect different questions and can't be compared directly - except from the ranking of the elements.
